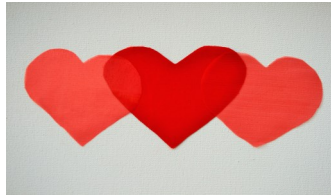

## PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

During the month of February, the teachers of the 3 year old classes, Mrs. Black's & Mrs. Yox's TTH & Mrs. Howard's classes and will be having conferences with the parents of the children in their classes. All these teachers will post sign-up sheets at their doors. Please sign up for a time that is convenient for you to meet with your child's teacher. If at all possible, make arrangements to come without your child.

## REGISTRATION FOR NEXT YEAR

On Tuesday, February 20, we will begin registration for next year for Families who currently have children enrolled at Green-Oak. Registrations will be until March 5, when classes are in session. Registration Fees must be paid with registration. If you need a specific class or time, I recommend that you register as soon as possible. Open Registration for next year will begin March 5. We will continue to take registrations every day when school is in session. The children who are registered will be divided into classes over the summer for the next school year. Our policy is to place a returning child with a teacher who is new to him and not have him repeat with the same teacher. We find this provides the best learning situation for the child.

## VALENTINE PARTIES

Wednesday, Feb. 14 and Thursday, Feb. 15 will be the Valentine Parties. For the Valentine's party, have your child bring in Valentines for her classmates. In the 3-4 year old classes, the child or parent should sign the Valentine and then put it in an envelope with no name on the outside. In the 4-5 year old classes, the child should sign the Valentine as best as he can and the child or parent should put his classmates names on the outside of the envelope. Attached is a list of the names of the children in your child's class. Parents who help at the party cannot bring other children to the party, Unless they are registered students. It is state law. Only parents may attend parties.

## INCOME TAX INFORMATION

If both parents are working while your child is in Preschool, you may be eligible for the credit for child and dependent care on your income taxes. Preschool tuition can be considered a child care expense. If you are eligible for this credit you may contact Mrs. Baker for the Preschool's tax ID number.
